A national cybersecurity curriculum will ensure that cybersecurity education is equitable for all, thus creating equal opportunities as everyone will be afforded the same chances.

In 2023, we have made great strides:

- We've successfully trained fifty program participants in our first year with the T-ATP curriculum.
- We also established working relationships with policymakers such as the White House and the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction to provide equitable cybersecurity education to all.
